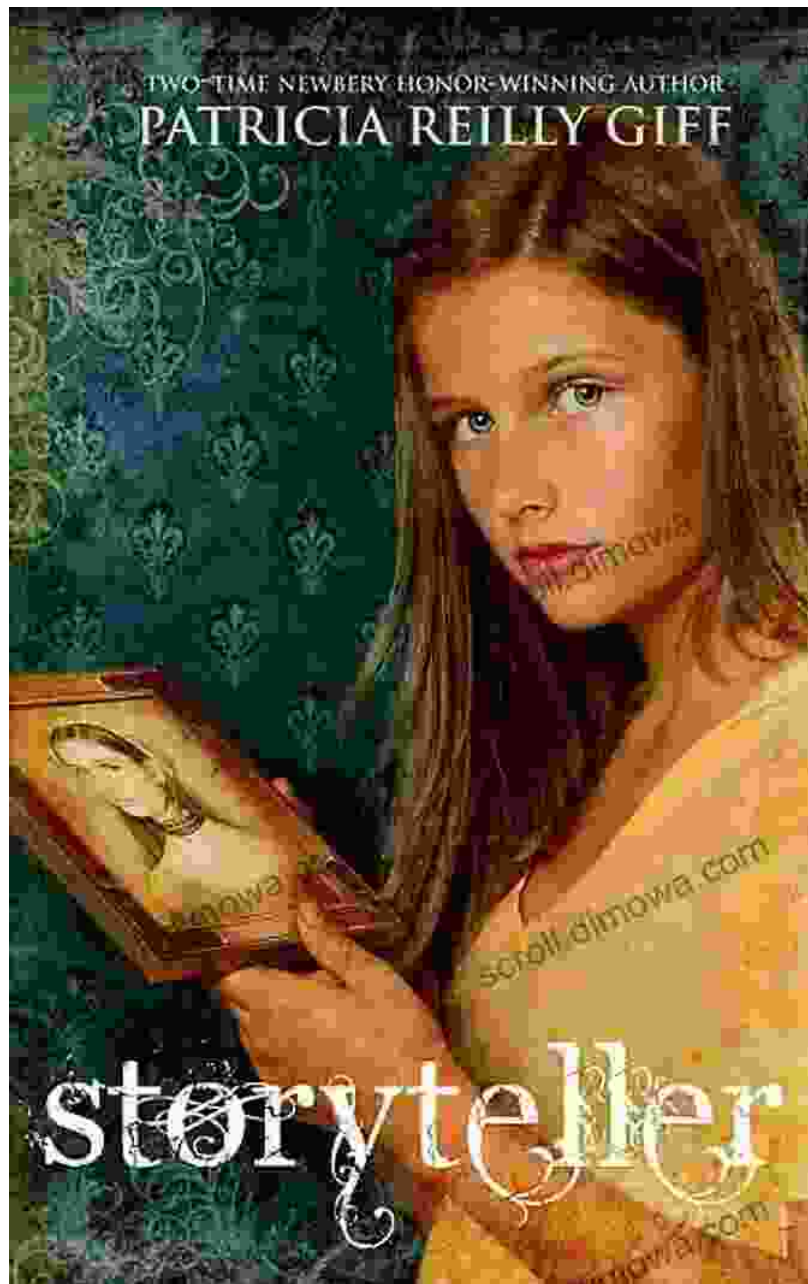


Patricia Reilly Giff: The Storyteller
