

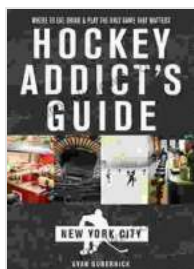

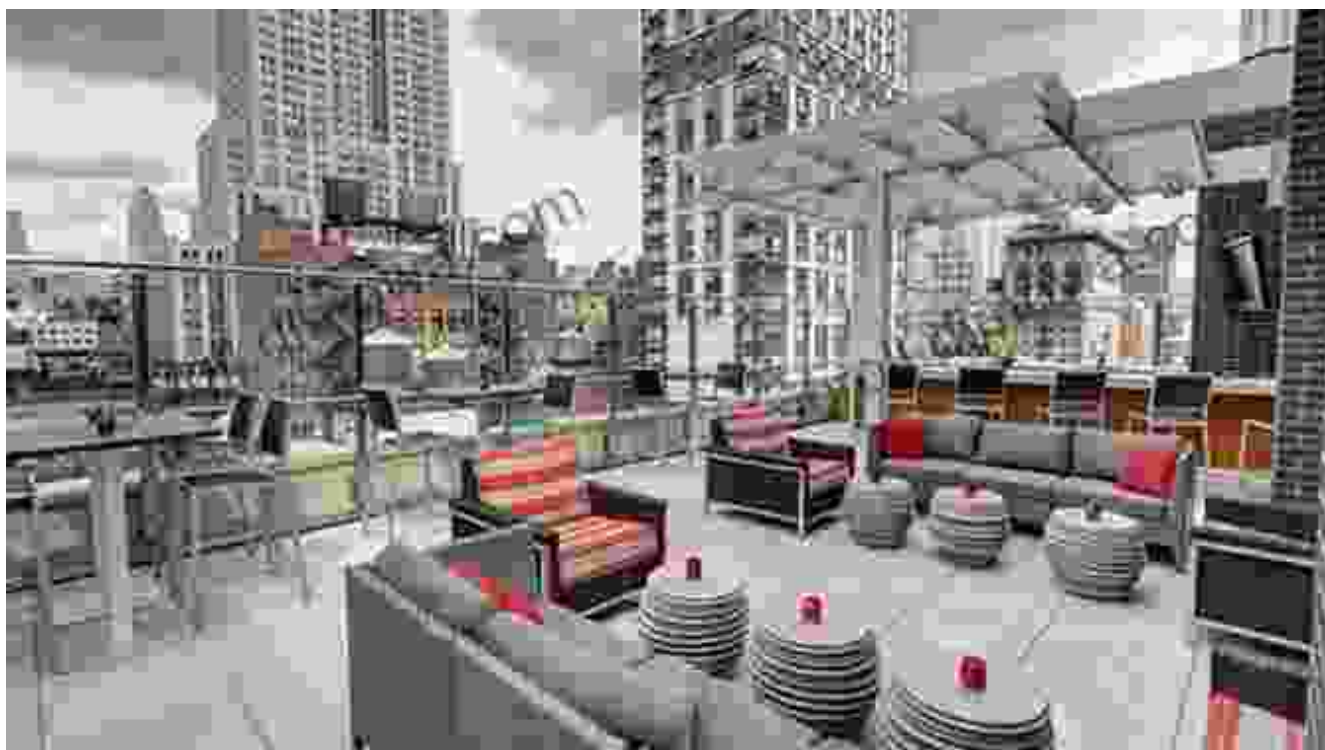


Bars

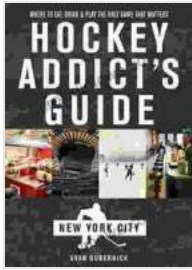

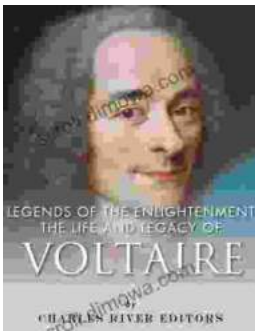
