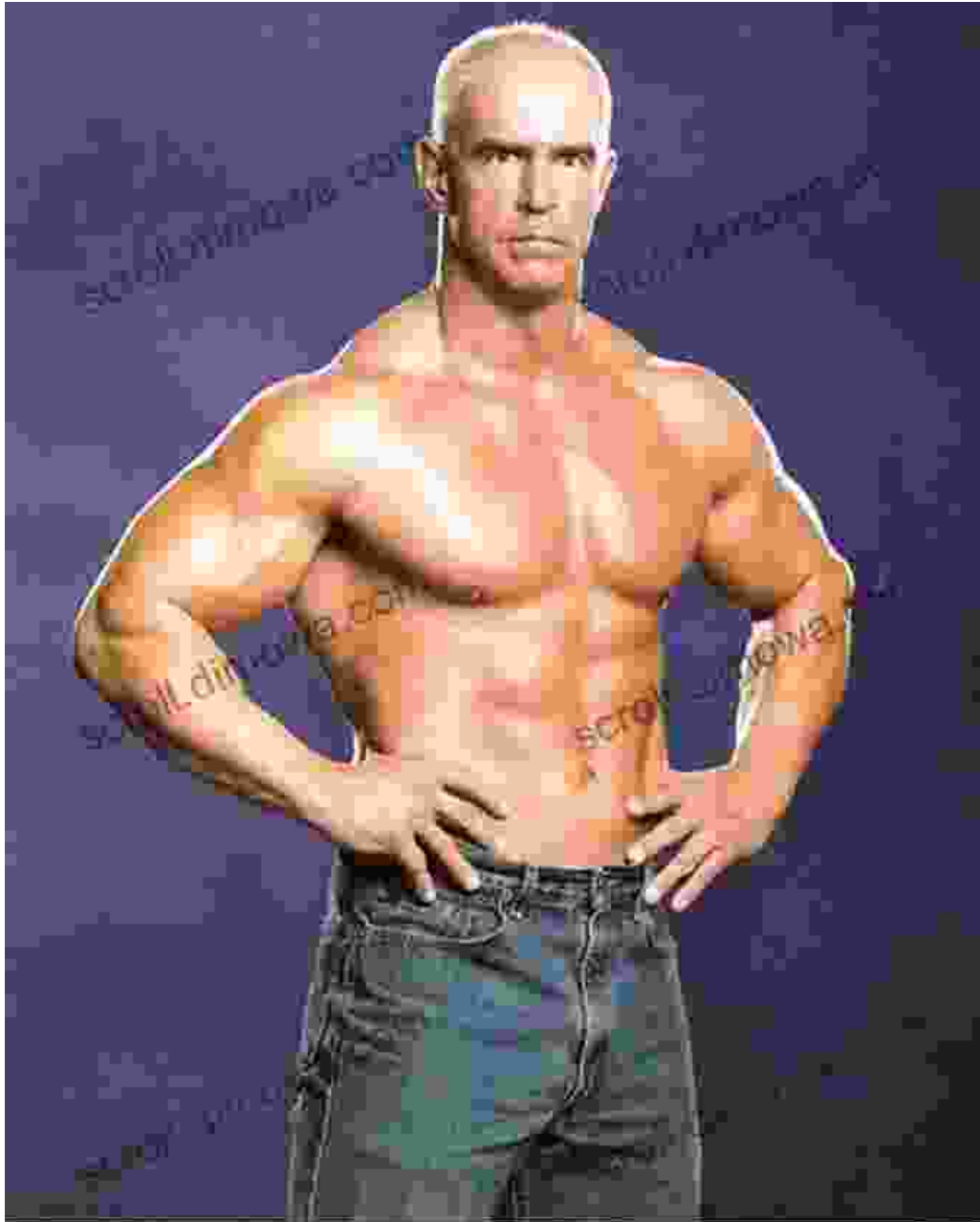

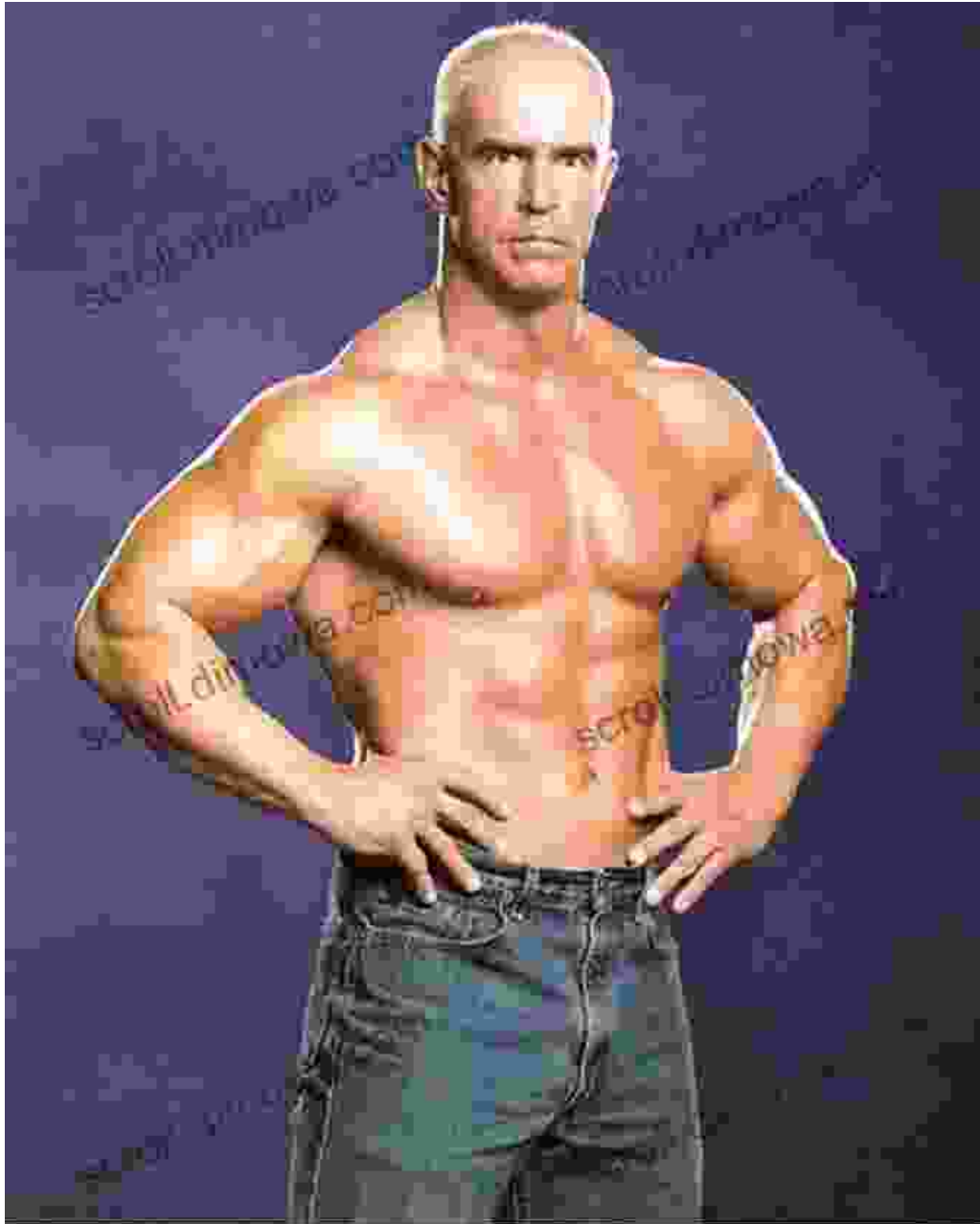
WWF/E Dominance

Outside the ring, Bob Holly is known for his outspoken personality and love of classic rock music. He married Danielle Maxie in 2018. The couple has two children.



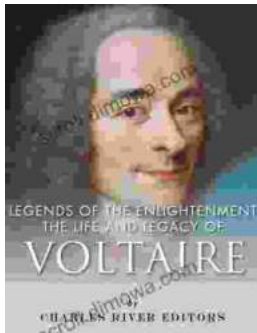

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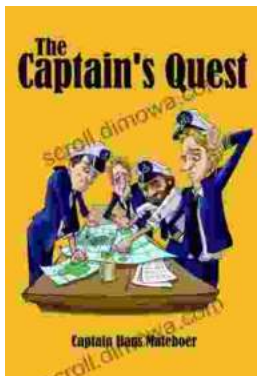
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
